## Visa Application Worksheet for Brazil

In my 29 plus year of travel experience, the Brazilian Visa is one of the trickiest visas to acquire. To help us with the process we will be using Globus' recommended visa service – Generations Visa. **New in 2018** is the ability to apply for our Brazilian Visa through the Brazilian Consulate via the web (**E-Visa**).

This avoids the need to mail our passport back-and-forth and thankfully cost much less. **The fee for the Brazilian Visa including processing is \$95 per person.** This will be collected with your final payment.

Since this process is New and the Brazilian Visa is tricky, I want to get started ASAP.

I would like to receive all materials back to me via regular mail by **Friday, April 28, 2018.**

It would be appreciated, if you could **avoid folding** the passport copy. Mahalo!

1. A **High Resolution (600 dpi)** COLOR copy of the data pages (2 pages – Bio data and signature with eagle) of your valid PASSPORT. (*Visit UPS Store, Kinko FedEx, Office Max, etc.*)
  - Must be valid **past March of 2019** (6 months beyond stay) and
  - **Standard size** (no enlargement or reduction) and
  - Must have at least **5 completely blank visa pages** (amendment pages *do not* count as visa pages)
2. One (1) **High Resolution 2” x 2”** current passport photo (pure white background; no shadow; both ears must be showing; no glasses and no smiling)
3. This completed E-Visa worksheet form.

**Please Note:** for travel into Brazil, each traveler must carry their valid passport on them. The Brazil E-Visa is electronic and will NOT be stamped inside the passport. The E-Visa is submitted online with the E-Visa approval communicated via email to Dold World Journeys. **You MUST carry the E-Visa approval with you always.**
