- Unique experiences like learning how to make a traditional Greek *tzatziki* appetizer and a *sirtaki* dance lesson.
- Scenic highlights include our drive through the rugged Mountains of Arcadia, the fantastic landscape of Meteora with its 24 rock-top monasteries, along the coastal highway to Thermopylae, and the crystal-clear Aegean Sea.

Itinerary

- **Day 1. Honolulu Departure.** Our classical and mythical Greek adventure and cruise begins this afternoon with a departure for the east coast where we make a comfortable connection to Europe. Once the preliminary flight schedule is ready it will be displayed online <u>doldworldjourneys.com</u> under the journey's page.
- Day 2. Via Germany to Athens, Greece. We are scheduled to arrive into Newark in the morning and transfer to a nearby hotel for day use rooms. In the early evening, we board our direct flight to Germany.
- Day 3. Arrival in Athens, Greece. After a brief stretch, depart on a two and half hour hop to Athens, Greece arriving there at noon. We clear customs formalities, are met by our specially chosen Greece Tour Director, and transfer to the Hotel Electra, our home for the next two nights. Tonight, celebrate the start of our journey with a Welcome Drink at our hotel.
- Day 4. Exploring Athens. Start our day with a guided visit to the world-famous Acropolis, perched high on a rocky outcrop overlooking the city. Here we see the Parthenon, the Erechtheum with its Porch of Maidens, the Temple of Athena Nike, and enjoy a panoramic view which includes glimpses of the Temple of Olympian Zeus, Theater of Dionysus, and the beautifully preserved Theseum, where Socrates taught.

Later, a city orientation drive features the **Old Parliament House** and a picture stop at the **Panathenaic Stadium**. Built in the 2nd century AD, it is the only stadium in the world built entirely of marble, and was host to the opening and closing ceremonies of the first modern Olympics in 1896. The afternoon is at our leisure to relax or stroll through the amazing **Plaka** with Alex. Tonight, sample a glass of *Ouzo* and savor a Greek-style 4 course dinner at a festive taverna in the Plaka district. Folks dances will put us in a special mood reminiscent of *Zorba the Greek*. (B), (D)

Day 5. Via Corinth, Mycenae and Epidaurus to Nauplia. Today begin our sojourn through the land of antiquity. We drive along the coast to the bridge crossing the spectacular Corinth Canal. The canal separates the Peloponnesus from the Greek mainland. Stop and wander through the remain of the ancient city of Corinth, where St. Paul preached.

Then on to **Mycenae** and the 19th-century excavations reveal impressions of the splendors so vividly described by Homer. Admire the **Beehive Tombs**, the **Treasury of Atreus**, **Lion Gate** - Europe's oldest known monument, remains of **Agamemnon's Royal Palace**, and the impressive fortifications of the **Citadel**. Spend time in the museum before a short drive to **Epidaurus** and its **Sanctuary of Asclepius**, *God of Medicine* (UNESCO). Explore its amazingly well-preserved 2,300-year-old open-air theater. Finally, we arrive in **Nauplia**, the classiest small city in all of Greece. Amalia Nauplia Hotel. (B), (D)

- **Day 6. To Olympia.** Spectacular scenery as our motorcoach takes us on a drive through the **Arcadian Mountains** to **Olympia**. Spend the afternoon where the athletes of antiquity competed in honor of the king of deities. Learn about the history of those original Olympic Games held in 776 B.C. as we stroll among the impressive remains of the **Gymnasium** and the **Temples of Hera** and **Zeus**. Enjoy the museum which features Praxiteles' magnificent statue of **Hermes**. Tonight, we enjoy a cooking demonstration and learn how to make the traditional Greek *tzatziki* appetizer. Europa Hotel. (B), (D)
- **Day 7. Via Patras to Delhi.** Via the busy seaport of **Patras**, we proceed through the picturesque fishing villages along the south coast of the mainland to mystic **Delphi**. The afternoon is devoted to a fascinating discovery of the ancient sanctuary of the god **Apollo** in its dramatic setting on the slopes of **Mount Parnassus**. Hear about the *Oracle* as we walk with our guide along the *Sacred Way* and explore this ancient Archaeological Site. We end our day with a visit to the museum to admire the **Charioteer**, an extraordinary 5th-century BC bronze statue. Our highlight this evening is a dance lesson, where we learn how to dance the *sirtaki*, made famous in the movie *Zorba the Greek*. A glass of the traditional *Ouzo* will help loosen our feet. Amalia Hotel Delphi. (B), (D)
- Day 8. To Kalambaka (Meteora Area). North is our heading today. We drive over the Pourmaraki Pass to Lamia, and then on via Trikala to Kalambaka. Here we take in the unreal, fantastic landscape of Meteora with its 24 rock-top monasteries. You will always remember the first time you see the monasteries and we have the privilege to visit two of them: Varlaam Monastery, famous for its frescoes, and St. Stephen's Monastery, featuring a unique collection of icons and an incredible panoramic view. Amalia Hotel Kalambaka. (B), (D)
- **Ladies need to pack a long skirt, as shorts or trousers are inappropriate when visiting the monasteries.
- **Day 9. Via Thermopylae to Athens.** After breakfast, we take a scenic drive along the coast to **Thermopylae**. Take a guided stroll on the site of the heroic battle of Leonidas' 300 doomed Spartans against Xerxes' huge Persian army. On the way back to Athens, our Tour Director will tell us about **Thebes**, the setting of *Sophocles' Oedipus Rex*, and **Marathon**,

where 10,000 Athenians defeated more than twice that number of Persian invaders in 490 BC. Tonight, admire the illuminated harbor of **Mikrolimano**, before driving to the yachting marina for a dinner at one of the city's most finest restaurants. Zafolia Hotel. (B), (D)

Day 10. Via Piraeus (Embarkation) To Mykonos. This morning we are transferred to **Piraeus** to board our ship. Sail into the deep-blue waters of the **Aegean Sea**, easily settling into the cruising routine. Later dock at the mountainous island of **Mykonos** with its characteristic windmills and dazzling white houses. Enjoy a few hours wandering the narrow-paced streets lined with trendy boutiques and shady taverns. (B), (L), (D)

Our Celestyal's **Crystal** yacht inspired design and classic teak decks evoke an intimate atmosphere. Enjoy comfortable staterooms, elegant restaurants, bars and lounges, spa, fitness rooms and activities, as well as promenade decks, where we can revel in the splendor of a starlit ocean sky. Indulge in rich culinary delights cooked from scratch by talented chefs and savor fresh Mediterranean ingredients. Our cruise offers a variety of interactive arts and crafts sessions to unleash your creativity as well as fun and friendly dance lessons, games, and demonstrations. The vessel is fully air-conditioned, has stabilizers, telephone, fax, satellite telephone and physician on board. See the Ship Details page for more information.

- **Day 11.** Cruising Kusadasi, Turkey and Patmos, Greece. Two ports of call for us today. First, discover Kusadasi on the Turkish coast where we visit the fascinating Greek, Roman, and Byzantine excavations of **Ephesus**. Next, join an optional excursion to discover the tiny Greek island of **Patmos**. Here we have the opportunity to visit the Grotto of the Apocalypse where St. John the Divine wrote the *Book of Revelation* and the 11th-century Monastery of St. John with its valuable manuscript collection (both UNESCO sites). (B), (L), (D)
- **Day 12. Cruising Rhodes.** The day is dedicated to the beautiful island of **Rhodes**. Explore the sights in the historic Old City with its ramparts and palaces built by the *Knights of St. John* during the Crusades. Next is **Lindos** with the fabulous **Temple of Athena**. For our independent wanderers, the colorful shopping districts are within easy walking distance from the port. Sail from Rhodes around dinnertime. (B), (L), (D)
- **Day 13. Cruising Heraklion, Crete to Santorini, Greece.** Our first port of call today is **Heraklion**, the largest city and capital of the Island of **Crete**. A few miles away is **Knossos**, the center of the 3000 BC Minoan civilization. Afternoon call (*weather permitting*) at **Santorini**. A volcano embraced by the Aegean, this island-phenomenon in the Cyclades gives its visitors a mythical experience. Perhaps join one of the optional shore excursions either to the volcano or up to the cliff-top village of Oia for one of the world's most breathtaking panoramas. (B), (L), (D)
- **Day 14. Disembarkation in Athens.** After breakfast on board we disembark at **Piraeus**. We transfer to the Hotel Electra for our last night in the ancient city. Time to relax or maybe do some last-minute souvenir shopping. Alex and our local guide will have some options. (B)
- **Day 15. To Honolulu.** Wonderful memories of a classical and mythical experience are with us as we return home. Our flight arrives in Honolulu in the late evening. (B)

General Conditions - Greece

DEPOSIT AND FINAL PAYMENT: A \$250 per person *credit card* **deposit** (*please CALL with your information*) processed by the Globus Family is required to secure your space and your **RESERVATION FORM** to set your discount spot. This deposit is part of your final payment, which is due no later than **65 days** prior to departure. You will receive a final payment request approximately two weeks before its due date. Final payment will be divided, with the land portion going to the Globus Family and the domestic airfare plus any non-chargeable costs going to ES International (DWJ's airline ticketing agent).

Sign-up discounts are combinable with other discounts, but are not transferable to other programs. **Land-only** space is limited. Land price does NOT include airport transfers, dayrooms, or pre or post night hotel accommodations. *These can be purchased*.

CANCELLATION AND REFUND: Full refund* will be made, if cancellation is received up to **120 days** prior to departure; thereafter, only the monies which will be recovered from the hotels, tour operators, airlines, etc., will be refunded. No refund will be made for services not used once the tour commences. All refunds or penalties are subject to the rules and tariffs of the vendors concerned. (*Note: once your airline ticket is issued it is non-refundable.) There is a \$25 fee for any changes made after 90 days.

TRAVEL INSURANCE: We recommended purchasing travel insurance with your DEPOSIT. This will insure you are covered from a pre-existing condition AND "Cancel for Any Reason." We will send you a copy of the coverage offered for this journey. This insurance is refundable up to **120 days** prior to departure. You can also purchase insurance with final payment but **will not** be covered for a pre-existing condition or "Cancel for Any Reason."

PRICE: Prices are per person based on two people sharing a room/cabin and accurate as of September 22, 2017. Our program prices are guaranteed (unless taxes increase). We need a minimum of 14 people flying with the group to operate this program.

PRICE INCLUDES: The journey price includes airfare (and taxes) based on a special group fare, which is subject to certain restrictions; accommodations in First or Superior First-Class hotels/ships based on two people sharing a room/cabin with private facilities (bath or shower); meals as indicated in the itinerary: (B) breakfast, (L) lunch, and (D) dinner; and entrance fees where applicable.

BAGGAGE: Due to limited motorcoach capacity, only one suitcase (50 lbs maximum) and one carry-on per person will be allowed. Porterage for this suitcase is included in the journey's price. Airline baggage fees are not included. No responsibility is accepted for loss of or damage to baggage or any of the passengers' belongings. We recommend buying travel insurance.
