

- Scenic highlights abound with scenic Lake Zurich, Lake Walen, the Swiss and Bavarian Alps, Rhine Valley, 7,504-foot Juiler Pass, beautiful Engadine Valley, renown Roseg Valley, Italy's Lake Como, subtropical Lake Lugano, Lake Maggiore, lofty Simplon Pass, Swiss Valais, the spectacular Matterhorn, lower Rhone Valley, majestic Lake Geneva, the amazing Tyrolean Mountains, plus, plus, plus.

Itinerary

- **Day 1. Honolulu Departure.** Our Oberammergau experience begins this evening with a departure for the west coast. Once the preliminary flight schedule is ready it will be displayed online at <u>doldworldjourneys.com</u> under the journey's page.
- **Day 2. Day use rooms in Newark.** We are scheduled to arrive into Newark in the morning and transfer to a nearby hotel where we have our own rooms to freshen up and relax. Then it is a non-stop flight to **Zurich**, Switzerland. *Air schedule is subject to change!*
- **Day 3.** Arrival in Zurich, Switzerland. Our arrival is in the early morning. After clearing customs formalities, we are met with a smile by Dino Koftis, our amazing European Tour Director, and transfer to the Moevenpick Airport Hotel, where we spend the night. Our rooms will be ready for us to freshen up and rejuvenate. In the afternoon, all are welcomed to wander with Alex to help us acclimate. Tonight, celebrate the start of our journey with a welcome dinner at our hotel. (D)
- Day 4. Via Vaduz, Liechtenstein to St. Moritz, Switzerland. Medieval heritage every step of the way this morning. Discover the charm of Zurich's Old Town on an orientation. Admire the guild houses and taste the traditional Chocolate Pralines at the famous Sprüngli Confectionery. Then a scenic drive following Lake Zurich and Lake Walen through the high Alps to the pocket-sized Principality of Liechtenstein, known for its fancy postage stamps. After a break in its capital, Vaduz, ascend the Rhine Valley into the mountainous Grisons, a canton where three of the country's four languages are spoken.
- The 7,504-foot **Julier Pass**, an important Alpine road since Roman times, leads us to the **Engadine**. This valley is considered by many as the most beautiful mountain area in the world, with deep-blue lakes, airy larch forests that turn golden in the fall, mountain peaks exceeding 12,000 feet, and quaint villages with massive white stone houses in the characteristic Grisons style. Afternoon arrival in ritzy **St. Moritz** and our Laudinella Hotel. For a special treat, travel to the mountain village of Pontresina where our horse-drawn carriage awaits. We ride into the untouched Alpine forest through the fragrant Swiss pines and larch wood with an amazing view of the glacier. (B), (D)
- Day 5. Via Lake Como, Italy to Lugano, Switzerland. A gradual change of scenery as we descend towards the enchanting shores of Italy's Lake Como and continue to the southern tip of Switzerland. The vegetation south of the Alps is Mediterranean: chestnut groves, vineyards, and olive and fig trees make us forget that earlier today we were within walking distance of glaciers.

Afternoon arrival in the popular subtropical resort town of **Lugano** in the Italian-speaking part of Switzerland. Time for shopping under the arcades of *Via Nassa* or an espresso on flower-festooned Piazza Riforma. This evening we cruise breathtaking **Lake Lugano**, followed by dinner at a traditional "grotto" restaurant. De La Paix Hotel. (B), (D)

Day 6. Via Stresa, Italy and Täsch, Switzerland to Zermatt. Our coach takes us from Lake Lugano to the Italian shore of Lake Maggiore for a break in the elegant town of Stresa. Here we take a boat ride to the last privately-owned island, Isola Bella. Enjoy a guided visit of the Borromeo Palace and stroll into a traditional Italian Market. It's a taste of Italian elegance with its romance, art architecture and history in a Mediterranean setting.

Later we continue over lofty **Simplon Pass**, connecting the Pennine Alps to the Lepontine Alps, and head into the **Swiss Valais**, an area renowned for its excellent wines and majestic mountain resorts. To reach the most famous of them, we leave the coach behind in **Täsch** and board a **Mountain Train** to climb the last few miles up to car-free **Zermatt**, a picturesque cluster of rustic chalets beneath the shadow of magnificent **Matterhorn**, one of the highest summits in the Alps and Europe. Pollux Hotel. (B)

Day 7. To Lake Geneva. This morning for a spectacular view of the surrounding Alps, take the exciting optional excursion by cable car to 12,739-foot-high **Klein Matterhorn** or savor some free time to wander the town and window shop for expensive Swiss-made watches, cuckoo clocks and cow bells.

Later we travel by coach through the vineyards and apricot groves of the lower **Rhône Valley**, the German speaking part of Switzerland. We arrive at beautiful **Lake Geneva**, one of the largest lakes in Europe, and our Eurotel Montreux Hotel in the late afternoon. (B), (D)

Day 8. Via Berne to Lucerne. Begin our day in the stately capital of **Berne** with our guided visit of the **Bear Park**. Here we see the native brown bear living in a landscape where they can climb, fish and play. Then savor a panoramic view of the city from the **Rose Garden** and enjoy a guided stroll through the beautifully preserved medieval **Old Town** where we witness the hourly parade of painted figures at the *Clock Tower* and take pictures of ornate, flower-adorned fountains.

Our highlight of the day is a **special lunch** at a traditional **Swiss working farm** with a chance to see how people live in rural Switzerland. Then continue over **Brünig Pass** to picture-book **Lucerne** where we spend two nights at the Romantik Hotel Wilden Mann. How about joining a Swiss folklore party with yodeling and alphorn blowing? (B), (L)

Day 9. Discovering Lucerne. Medieval heritage every step of the way this morning. Discover the charm of this city as we stroll with Dino through cobbled lanes to the city walls and listen as he explains its history. Admire Thorwaldsen's impressive **Lion Monument**, dedicated to the Swiss Guards who protected the Royal House of France during the French Revolution, and the ornate patrician houses of the walled **Old Town**. Cross the famous covered **Chapel Bridge** to the Jesuit Church. Some free time to shop for Swiss watches before another true Swiss experience: a trip to the top of **Mount Pilatus**, the "*Guard of Lucerne*," where we receive a special *Souvenir Cap!* A special dinner awaits us at our hotel for a proper *auf Wiedersehen* to Switzerland. (B), (D)

Day 10. Via Innsbruck, Australia to Munich, Germany. A comfortable drive brings you via Zurich to Innsbruck in the Austrian Tyrol mountains. Enjoy a walk through the Old Town to quaint medieval lanes to Emperor Maximilian's Golden Roof. Sumptuously decorated with 2,657 fire-gilded copper tiles, all still original. Then, continue to Munich, capital of Bavaria and home of the annual Oktoberfest celebration. Our Holiday Inn Munich City Centre hotel is set within a shopping complex and a 30-minute walk to Munich's Old Town. (B)

Day 11. To Oberammergau. Germany's "Secret Capital" comes alive during our orientation drive featuring the **Olympic Stadium**, 1,000-foot-high **Olympic Tower**, and **Marienplatz**, in the historic heart of the city. Then it is off to the lush Bavarian Alps and picturesque Oberammergau. A fantastic Globus highlight is our hotel is located in this quaint little village. This gives us the opportunity to wander at our leisure. The place will be crowded with tourists during the day, but at night we'll have this charming Bavarian village all to ourselves. (B), (D)

Day 12. Oberammergau and the Passion Play. The Passion Play presents Christ's Passion, beginning with His entry into Jerusalem and ending with His resurrection and transfiguration. All participants in the Passion Play must be native to Oberammergau, no small feat since there can be up to 600 elaborately costumed actors and a chorus and orchestra of 100 strong on the open-air state at one time. There is so much involved the locals start getting ready and rehearsing over a year before the event. Currently it is held every 10 years.

The afternoon and evening are dedicated to the world-famous Oberammergau Passion Play, currently performed every 10 years. (See descriptive flyers). (B), (L), (D)

Day 13. Back to Munich. After breakfast we have a little time to browse Oberammergau one more time. Be sure to savor the beautiful and colorful frescoes painted on the outside of many buildings, catch a glimpse of the woodcarvers at work, and/or pick up a few Christmas ornaments. A short drive back through the Bavarian Alps we return to Munich for the night. Perhaps hoist a few steins at the famous Hofbrauhaus. The evening is free to do as we please. Alex and Dino will be available with suggestions. (B)

Day 14. To Honolulu. Vivid memories of an Alpine extravaganza and spectacular Oberammergau experience are with us as we return home. Our flight arrives in Honolulu in the late evening. (B)

General Conditions - Oberammergau

DEPOSIT AND FINAL PAYMENT: A \$250 per person credit card **DEPOSIT** (*please CALL it in*) processed by the Globus Family is required to secure your space and your **RESERVATION FORM** to set your discount spot. On **June 15, 2019**, a second DEPOSIT of \$350 will be due. These deposits are part of your final payment, which is due no later than **65 days** prior to departure. You will receive a final payment request approximately two weeks before its due date. Final payment will be divided, with the land portion going to the Globus Family and the international airfare plus any non-chargeable costs going to ES International (DWJ's airline ticketing agent).

Sign-up discounts are combinable with other discounts, but are not transferable to other programs. **Land-only** space is limited. Land price does NOT include airport transfers, dayrooms, or pre- or post- night hotel accommodations. *These can be purchased*.

CANCELLATION AND REFUND: Both deposits are **NON-REFUNDABLE**. After final payment, only the monies which will be recovered from the hotels, tour operators, airlines, etc., will be refunded. No refund will be made for services not used once the tour commences. All refunds or penalties are subject to the rules and tariffs of the vendors concerned. (Note: Once your airline ticket is issued it is non-refundable.) There is a \$25 fee for any changes made after 90 days.

TRAVEL INSURANCE: We recommended purchasing travel insurance with your DEPOSIT. This will insure you are covered from a pre-existing condition AND "Cancel for Any Reason." We will send you a copy of the coverage offered for this journey. This insurance is refundable up to **June 15, 2019**. You can also purchase insurance with final payment but **will not** be covered for a pre-existing condition or "Cancel for Any Reason." NOTE - "Cancel for Any Reason" does **NOT** cover the \$250 or \$350 deposits.

LAND PRICE: Land price is per person based on two people sharing a room/cabin and accurate as of October 12, 2017. Our Land Price is guaranteed (unless taxes increase). We need a minimum of 14 people flying with the group to operate this journey.

AIR PRICE: Air price is an estimate based on 2018 fares and SUBJECT TO CHANGE. My goal is to bring down these costs.

PRICE INCLUDES: The journey price includes accommodations in First- or Superior First-class hotels/ships based on two people sharing a room/cabin with private facilities (bath or shower); meals as indicated in the itinerary: (B) breakfast, (L) lunch, and (D) dinner; and entrance fees where applicable.

NOT INCLUDED: The trip price does not include passport expenses; meals not listed above; all beverages; Country tax; baggage fees; baggage and health insurance; laundry expenses; and all items of a personal nature. Tips to tour directors, tour drivers, local guides, and hotel personnel; excursions; city sightseeing; and entrance fees are excluded unless specifically noted in the itinerary.

PASSPORT AND DOCUMENTS: A passport, valid 6 months past the date of your return with at least 3 blank pages, is required. Tourist Visas are not required for U.S. citizens on this journey. A copy of your passport is due with final payment.

SINGLE SUPPLEMENT: Single rooms are **limited** and on REQUEST. For persons traveling alone who wish to share hotel rooms, every effort will be made to find you a roommate; however, if this is not possible, through choice or circumstance, the single supplement must be charged (*if a single room is still available*).

SIGHTSEEING AND TRANSFERS: All sightseeing and transfers are by private deluxe air-conditioned motorcoach with extra leg room. No Smoking on Globus coaches.

BAGGAGE: Due to limited motorcoach capacity, only one suitcase (50 lbs. maximum) and one carry-on per person will be allowed. Porterage for this suitcase is included in the journey's price. No responsibility is accepted for loss of or damage to baggage or any of the passengers' belongings. We recommend buying travel insurance.

RESPONSIBILITY: Dold World Journeys, LLC. and Group Voyagers Inc., dba Globus, 5301 S. Federal Circle, Littleton, CO 80123 (hereinafter referred to as "the Companies") are responsible to you in making arrangements for the tour services offered in the itinerary or on its Web site, including transportation, sightseeing, and hotel accommodations through independent contracts.

The carriers, hotels and other suppliers providing tour services are independent contractors and are not agents, employees, or servants of, or joint ventures with, the Companies or its affiliates. The motorcoach company and other carrier employees may not physically lift participants or assist them on or off transportation vehicles. Persons requiring such assistance must be accompanied by a qualified companion.

The tour participant agrees that neither the Companies nor its affiliates shall be liable for any damages, loss (including personal injury, death, and property loss), or expense occasioned by any act or omission of any supplier providing tour services or of any other person.
