Weather Information:

Day temperatures range between approximately 79° to 86°. The mornings and nights will tend to be cooler at an average of 64°. It is very difficult to predict the weather, so be prepared for extremes (58°F to 90°F): Sunny tropical weather will prevail on most days along with cooling trade winds at night. At our tour briefing we will give you the most current temperatures.

In general pack lighter clothes for the day. A medium jacket or long sleeve t-shirt will work well at night. Comfortable walking shoes are a must. Bring **casual dress** clothes (long pants and shoes) for dining. Baggage weight limit is 44 pounds.

Special Notes:

Cuba currency is the Cuban Convertible Pesos (CUC). One CUC is equal to 1 USD. US issued ATM, debit, and credit cards **cannot** be used in Cuba. It is best to carry US cash (\$10, \$20, \$50) which we will convert on arrival (for a minimal fee). A **money belt** is highly recommended.

Due to the US embargo on Cuba not much can be brought home. Also goods are not readily available for our needs so it is important to carry things like batteries, medicines, feminine products, Contact lens solution, toothpaste, Ziploc bags, etc.

Electrical outlets in Cuba are 110 V, so you **do not** need to bring a converter and an adapter. US cellular phones **do not** work in Cuba, but most hotels do have WIFI for a fee.
